True Cost of Education

The true cost of educating a child at St. Martin's is more than **\$7,500.00**. In an effort to make a quality Catholic education as affordable as possible, while also striving to be a model employer, St. Martin's Parish contributes a significant amount from the weekly offertory of all parishioners for the operations of the school. This parish support makes up part of the difference between the true cost of education and the amount of tuition collected. The remainder comes from fund-raisers. Many parents work countless hours each year to ensure the success of fund-raisers. Your help is needed. All Catholic families grow in their faith and help strengthen the parish family by being active and involved members of the St. Martin's community.

Registration Fee

This is a non-refundable fee, which counts toward tuition. It is due by February 15, 2010 for current families and one week after acceptance for new families. This fee must be sent in with the Registration Form unless some other arrangements have been made with Sister Sharon.

Payment Plans

All families pay the Academic Resource Fee and Lunchroom fee on July 15, 2010. Tuition payments (the balance remaining after the registration fee is applied) can be paid in one of three plans:

- Monthly Plan – 10 equal payments starting August 16, 2010, last payment in May 16, 2011.
- Semi-annual Plan – Two payments, due on August 16, 2010, and January 14, 2011.
- Annual Plan – One payment in full, due August 16, 2010.

The Academic Resources Fee for 2010-2011 is \$400. This fee helps provides funds to partially defray the costs of textbooks, technology, classroom supplies, special class events, some HSA activities, and other operational needs. The fee is charged on a per student basis. Due date: July 15, 2010.

The Lunchroom Fee for 2010-2011 is \$50. This fee provides funds to partially defray the costs of coordinating the parent network for daily lunchroom and playground volunteers. This fee is charged on a per family basis. Due date: July 15, 2010

Family Obligation

Paying tuition is a legal obligation. Consult your enrollment agreement as well as the School Handbook for further information concerning payments and late fees. Families of students that withdraw for any reason before the end of the second week of classes (approximately September 10) will receive a partial refund of tuition. Families of students that withdraw after the end of the second full week of classes (approximately September 10) are expected to pay the year's tuition in full.

Returning Families who did not apply for financial assistance from the Archdiocese using the **Private School Aid Service** or **PSAS Form that was due by December 4, 2009** -- may apply directly for assistance from St. Martin's by requesting and completing a special financial form. The documentation must include the 2009 Tax information. In future years – parents, requesting assistance from the Parish, must complete the PSAS form first in order to be eligible for assistance from St. Martin's Parish.

New Families Pre-Kindergarten – Grade 8 may apply for financial assistance from the Archdiocese using the **Private School Aid Service** or **PSAS Form**. **Parents may obtain this form at the following site beginning in February:**
